Wine List

White Wines

- 1 **Sauvignon Blanc** 'Family Vineyard', Wairau River, Marlborough, New Zealand £ 28.95
A clean classic Sauvignon Blanc from the beautiful Marlborough vineyards located in the maritime coastal plains of New Zealand's south island. Expressive aromas of gooseberry and passion fruit, with a finish of great length.
- 2 **Chardonnay** Bon Vallon Sur Lie De Wetshof Estate Robertson South Africa £ 37.00
This is a fresh and expressive unwooded Chardonnay, matured on its lees to produce a vibrant, lemony dry wine with a yeasty and delicate nutty finish. A great example of quality winemaking from the King of Chardonnays.
- 3 **Picpoul de Pinet** Sel et de Sable, France £ 31.00
Picpoul is a bright straw yellow in colour with a very fresh and floral nose. The palate is dry and refreshing with notes of citrus, some tropical fruits and a distinctive mineral edge. 250ml: £ 10.50
- 4 **Pinot Grigio** San Antini, Italy £ 23.00
Delicate colour, this light bodied Pinot Grigio has a ripe fruit aroma with pear and melon flavours on the palate. Crisp and dry, it has balanced acidity with a long lingering finish. 250ml: £ 8.00

- 5 **Sauvignon Blanc** Potager du Sud £ 22.00
Cotes de Gascogne France 250ml: £ 7.50
A crisp, dry white with aromas of citrus fruits, particularly grapefruit and nettles, flavours that linger on the palate with hints of pear and melon and a lively acidity. 175ml: £ 6.00

- 6 **Chablis** Domaine Fevre, France £ 42.00
A very clear wine, fresh, light and fruity its flavours develop easily. Straw yellow colour, firm and supple with a long lasting finish.
- 7 **Pinot Grigio** Le Monde, Italy £ 30.95
A rich Pinot Grigio full of pure fruit flavours and definition. The palate is rich with flavours of peach, pear and melon and there is a soft, creamy texture with fresh acidity to match.
- 8 **Chardonnay** Moulin d'Argent, St Pourcin, France £ 27.00
This Chardonnay is super fresh and lively with a lovely twist of lemon acidity. Beautifully balanced and dry it also develops exotic fruits such as pineapple, banana and quince on the palate. 250ml: £ 9.00

- 9 **Gavi de Gavi Ca da Bosio** Terre da Vino, Piedmont, Italy £ 41.00
The soils in the central zone of Gavi di Gavi impart a perfumed mineral character adding complexity to lively aromas of ripe fruit and flowers. 'Ca da Bosio' is further refined by extended lees contact which imparts eloquent, complex, lingering hints of vanilla to the soft-textured dry finish.
- 10 **Chenin Blanc** Backsberg Estate, South Africa £ 29.95
Pear, green apple and cashew provide an array of aromatic characters. Ripe fruit is tempered by finely balanced acidity to give a mouth filling, yet refreshing palate, which has a lingering finish.
- 11 **Sancerre** Domaine Merlin Cherrier, France £ 42.00
Citrus, minerals aromas with finesse and precision combining a firm structure with an aromatic, blackcurrant character and an extra richness of gooseberry and lees on a long, zesty finish.

Rosé Wines

- 12 **'Whispering Angel' Rose** Chateau d'Esclans, France £ 39.00
A pale partridge eye pink with perfumed bouquet, followed by elegant summer fruits and beautifully integrated balancing acidity.
- 13 **Cinsault Rosé** La Vigneau £ 22.00
IGP Herault, France 250ml: £ 7.50
A beautiful coral colour with a palate of strawberry and cherry and a mouth filling creamy texture. Well made with a subtle balancing acidity. 175ml: £ 6.00
- 14 **Pinot Grigio Blush** San Antini, Italy £ 23.00
Lovely and lively on the palate, it has a burst of red berry fruit with a dry, lingering finish. 250ml: £ 8.00
175ml: £ 6.50

Dessert Wines

- 15 **Chateau les Mingets** Sauternes, France 37.5cl half btl: £ 36.00
A concentrated, luscious character, intense flavours of caramelized fruits, pear melon and almond, rounded and balanced by good acidity on the finish. 125ml: £ 12.00

Should a wine be unavailable a suitable alternative will be recommended



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Red Wines

- 16 **Malbec** Familia Schroeder `Alpataco` Patagonia, Argentina £ 29.95
Complex nose with a combination of red fruits such as cherries and a hint of violets. Smooth mouth feel, this is a fresh and fruit wine that carries vanilla and caramel notes from ageing in small oak barrels. 250ml: £ 10.00
175ml: £ 7.50
- 17 **Rioja Crianza `Torno` Hacienda el Ternero, Rioja, Spain** £ 37.00
100 % Tempranillo, this fantastic Crianza was aged for 12 months in French oak barrels before resting in bottle. The nose is perfumed with violets and cherries. The palate is fresh and structured with notes of black fruits with spices and hints of caramel from the oak influence on the finish.
- 18 **Chateau Gachon** Montagne, St Emilion, France £ 34.95
A deep ruby wine with purple hues and a soft nose of cherry, cassis, and spice. On the palate it is quite well balanced with a solid tannic structure and a complementary soft mid-palate of ripe red berry fruit.
- 19 **Merlot Petirrojo Reserva**, Colchagua Valley, Chile £ 22.00
An easy drinking, distinguished and vibrantly fruity red. The palate is rich with black cherry and plum flavours with a hint of mineral character and soft, rounded structure. 250ml: £ 7.50
175ml: £ 6.00

- 20 **Montepulciano d`Abruzzo Riserva** Tor Del Colle, Italy £ 38.00
Intense purple in colour with intense aromas of blackberries and cherries. The palate is round and rich with notes of ripe berry fruit, sweet black cherries a touch of liquorice and a distinctive spicy character from 12 months ageing in wooden casks.
- 21 **Malbec Reserve**, Finca Sopenia, Argentina £ 33.00
A wine of great concentration and complexity showing sweet and voluminous tannins.
- 22 **Shiraz** Impressionist Cosmic Cloud Western Cape, South Africa £ 22.00
A bright and bold Shiraz from the Western Cape with notes of ripe blackberries, plum and damson. Sweet spice combines with the juicy fruit to produce an eminently drinkable wine. 250ml: £ 7.50

- 23 **Pinot Noir** `Selection S`, Schubert, New Zealand £ 39.00
Intense aromas of blackcurrant and cherry along with smoke and tobacco notes. Aged in both old and new French oak barriques for 16 months, the wine is full bodied with rich and elegant textures.
- 24 **Cotes du Rhone Villages** Seguret l` Amandine, France £27.95
Black berry plump plum core. Medium- full bodied with aromas of lavender and rosemary.
- 25 **Lecco Crianza** Ribero del Duero, Spain £ 39.00
Ruby red in colour with a complex nose of black fruits and spice. On the palate, notes of black plum, cherries and berries combine with liquorice, bitter chocolate and a hint of balsamic on the finish.
- 26 **Saurus Malbec Barrel Fermented** Patagonia Select, Familia Schroeder, Argentina £ 45.00
Deep red colour with some hint of violet. Full ripened fruit aromas with strong plum and cassis gently backed with floral and spiced nuances. Delicate hints of vanilla and chocolate, a soft and elegant wine with a long lingering finish. If you like Malbec then we have gone with the best of Argentina here!
- 27 **Pinot Noir** Grand Arte, Portugal £31.95
This Portuguese Pinot Noir spent 9 months in French oak barrels adding toast and cedar notes to the fresh blackcurrant fruit, complemented by soft tannins and a fresh acidity. A new Portuguese Pinot Noir listing which might surprise you but do try it – it's delicious!
- 28 **Pinotage** Backsberg Estate, Paarl South Africa £29.00
When carefully grown with limited yields, it produces an appealing red fruit aroma, a soft palate with ripe mulberry, sweet strawberry and a touch of herbs. Easy drinking well balanced with supple tannins, this Cape red displays lively fresh flavours.
- 29 **Chateauneuf du Pape** Domaine du Grand Tinel, Rhone, France £55.00
This famous wine is produced from 50 year old vines grown on pebble strewn slopes, to give rich and powerful aromas of wild herbs and cedar backed by bold flavours of cherry, strawberry and prune.

Sparkling & Champagne

- 30 **Prosecco** Superiore, Bortolotti, Italy £ 33.00
This is a premium sparkling Prosecco, easy to drink and elegant with floral aromas of hedgerow blossoms and white fruits, fresh and lively with a creamy persistent mousse. 20cl btl: £ 11.00
- 31 **Pol Roger** White Foil Brut, France NV £ 75.00
Aromas of white flowers, green apples and a hint of minerality precede a vigorous flavour dominated with stone fruits and a touch of nuttiness. A lovely honey ripeness compliments a lively lemony acidity.
- 32 **Taittinger** Brut Reserve, France NV £ 73.00
Pale straw in colour with a consistent and fine mousse. The nose is light and delicate with hints of biscuit and brioche. The palate is lean, but has considerable depth and is elegant with a long fresh finish
